During Labor and Delivery

- We are planning an unmedicated vaginal delivery.

- I would appreciate positive language about birth, and for words like "pain" to be used as little as possible.

- When the time comes, I would like to push as my body leads, as long as the baby and I are not at risk.

After Birth

- We prefer delayed cord clamping, until the cord stops pulsating.
- I want to hold my baby skin-to-skin immediately after delivery.
- I would like to breastfeed as soon as possible after birth.
- We respectfully decline erythromycin eye ointment.
